To put the money raised into perspective, this amount would fund the entire Parent and Child Group for 10 weeks. The groups run daily for 2.5 hours and support children like Zoe. Zoe has been attending the Centre for 1 year and has gone from being unable to communicate or function independently - to being about to feed herself, sit for short periods of time, stand whilst holding onto the bars and even tell her mum that she would like to watch Peppa Pig!

Your support is also helping adults like Julia, who was diagnosed with MS in 2015. When Julia started attending The Rainbow Centre, she was very unsteady and wobbly on her feet which made her lack in confidence. Now she is a lot steadier on her feet, and is able to walk up and down stairs with confidence. Having learned techniques to get up from the floor, Julia is no longer afraid of falling, which means she is less likely to fall. Julia's big aim is to walk without her stick at her son's wedding. This goal now seems possible and she is well on the way towards achieving it.

Without donations and events like the Burns Night none of this would be possible, as we receive a minute proportion of funding from the government.

Thank you so much once again for supporting The Rainbow Centre, we're already looking forward to seeing you all again next year.
